Any alteration made to this form must be initialled by the person who signs it.
- 5 In the case of a corporation, this form must be executed either under its common seal or under the hand of some officer or attorney duly authorised in that behalf.
- 6 In the case of joint registered holders of any shares, the vote of the senior holder who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders. For this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names of the holders stand in the Register of Shareholders.
- 7 To be effective, this form must be duly completed and should be delivered together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed, or a notarially certified copy (where executed abroad) or official copy of that power or authority, to the Bank's Registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not later than 3:30 p.m. on 14 May 2013 or not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding any adjourned meeting (as the case may be).
- 8 Brief biographical details of all Directors who offer themselves for re-election at the Meeting are set out in Appendix II of the Circular to Shareholders dated 28 March 2013.
- 9 The Chairman will demand a poll on each of the resolutions to be proposed at the Meeting. On a poll, every shareholder present in person or by proxy shall have one vote for every share of which he/she is the holder.
